





OnTheMap and Google Earth

Assuming a 40-mile hurricane path going through the New Orleans area in the lower part of the map and Lake Pontchartrain in the middle. The blue dots represent the number of jobs for each of census blocks in the area outlined by the yellow line based on 2008 OnTheMap data. About 440,000 primary jobs depicted in this map.
